Is the funding provided as a grant or a loan?

1 GRANT

Which countries/institutions are welcomed for application?

2 All regions of Africa will be covered.

Will you consider my proposal if I'm outside the preferred countries/Institutions?

3 Yes, but only when you have partners based and registered in Africa

What is the rule of accessing the fund? Will you consider a proposal submitted directly by countries/institutions?

4 An application form provided by the MDF team should be filled and sent directly to the Coordinator or the Fund manager.

What is the frequency of the call of proposals?

5 Anytime as long as funds are available.

How early I need to submit my application?

6 At least 4 months prior to the starting date of the project.

What I have to know before I apply?

7 1. Existing activity ; 2. Legally registered in Africa; 3. Ability to contribute 30% of the total grant requested; 4. Project not exceeding 2 years duration.

I submitted my application. What happens next? (Process)

8 1. Preselection for eligibility; 2. Appraisal by the Technical Review Committee; 3. Appraisal by the Advisory Committee. 4. Grant application to be signed; 5. Request for applicant to meet conditions precedent; 6. First disbursement

How long does a request take to get approved?

9 Average of 70 days starting from the date the application is received the MDF team.

Where can I find the application form?

10 From the MDF manager or the MDF Coordinator.
